Introduction/ Opening remarks Given by Ruth Ann Pivik and Mrs. Loy

Mrs. Loy had a good report and reported that the students are working hard and coming along. They are getting ready for Side By Side Night this Friday.

<u>Secretary Minutes</u> Melissa Draganosky presented the minutes from September 7th's meeting and motion to approve the minutes was from Melissa Draganosky. Second by Mark Pivik. Minutes will be posted on the PMB website and app.

Treasurer's Report:

Heather presented the treasurer's report see attached report at end of the minutes on the last page. Just to clarify that money collected from Mrs. Loy by parents for show shirts, shoes and gloves, Allie Kiski shirts as well as senior parent corsages is an expense that is an in and out payment. Which means money collected by the Music Boosters for payment is sent out. The music boosters paid for the singer's masks. The PMB hopes through fundraising efforts to recoup the money for the masks.

General discussion about the following topics:

Ways and Means Joan Cocca:

Joan stated that the Peppi's hoagie pickup will be on October 13th from 4-6pm. It will be in the front of the Senior High School. The student accounts made \$1,294 with the hoagie sale. The next sale will be Pie Shop Pies that will be in time for Thanksgiving.

Joan also stated that we will do a Sarrs' candy sale for December with delivery in time for the Holidays. Then another Sarrs' candy sale around Easter time. More information will be put out onto the App about all fundraising.

Also just a reminder you have to be a member of the Plum Music Booster to Fundraise for students accounts. Students can use their accounts for things such as shoes, gloves, Senior night corsages, or trips. All money in senior student accounts can be gifted to another member in writing by June 30th of 2022. If after June 30, 2022 and you do not gift your money to another student all funds in that account will become part of the general funds.

<u>Hospitality:</u> Sara Henchar reported that they are getting a cookie try for the parents and families of the Junior and Elementary band students who will be coming to the Band Side By Side Night this Friday. The booster board will be on hand to answer any questions that the parents may have.

Mrs. Loy stated that no one gets into the game for free. Parents have to purchase tickets for the game. The younger band students will march into the field with the band, they do not need a ticket. The boosters will be on hand to sell tickets to anyone at Wednesday's practice. 7-8 graders will be permitted to stay in the stands and play along with the High School . Elementary will be dismissed to their parents after the pregame show.

Chaperones:

Chaperones are assigned to each game. Ruth Ann sent out a schedule to the Chaperones. IF you cannot chaperone a game just let her know ahead of time so a replacement can be made.

Membership:

Melissa Draganosky is membership chair. There are currently 72 families as Music Boosters members that include spouses.

<u>Chorus Liaison-</u> We have a new Chorus Liaison Robin Tongel. Robin is eager to work with the boosters and would like to have more parent involvement with the chorus parents.

Orchestra Liaison- We have a new Orchestra Liaison Gretchen Kelly.

General Fundraising

Jess Marks reported that the Moes' fundraiser raised \$412.50 and recommends we do another one. 50 kits were sold.

We will also have a restaurant night on October 19-and 20th at the North Park Lounge in Murrysville. You need to present the flyer to your wait staff for the fundraiser.

Jess also reported that we are going to host a bingo fundraising on November 7th from 12pm to 4pm. Tickets will sell for \$30 and will include lunch. Tickets will be on sale on Wednesday 8pm PHS bus lot at home games at the Band Clothing Table near the concessions, and on 10/9 at the band review night.
