Our candles are hand-poured using only the finest ingredients.

We use special 100% soy bean wax which allows our candles to absorb more fragrance.

Soy wax is cleaner burning with little to no soot and burns 30-40% longer than other waxes.

Best of all, our candles are affordably priced! Customers rarely buy just one.

Burn time is 45-50 hours for the 9 ounce candles!

Candle care and burning instructions should be included with each order and you should print that form as well and put with each order sold!!

Candle Variety

You will have 8 fragrances for customers to choose from. And will be available in both candle and/or melt to purchase. Candles are 9oz and wax melts have 6 individual squares of the scent.

Payment and Profit:

Individual customers are to make checks out to person selling product!!!

1. One check for total amount owed to us after you take your 40% must be payable to Oakmont Candle Works and the FINAL FORM only is to be turned in as soon as your sale is finished. We do not pour your order until both are given to us. Once we receive both we will pour order and call you when finished. You will then put together all individual orders on your own. We only take the Final Form with all Final totals. We cannot add onto order once we receive check and final form.

Order deadline will be confirmed with OCW

Most fundraisers run for 2-3 weeks.

Once all orders are placed, please allow 2 weeks for delivery. During the holidays, please allow extra time.

CARING FOR YOUR CANDLE

1. First and foremost. Trim. Your. Wick!

2. Recenter your wick when needed! If the wick shifts (which is not uncommon towards the end of candle life) be sure to fix it!

3. Burning your candle for the first time....

The first time you light up a new candle, let it burn for a couple hours until the pool of wax reaches the edge of the glass. If you don't, you run the risk of burning straight down the center of the candle and missing out on precious hours of fabulous fragrance.

4. That being said, don't burn your candle for too long either!

3-4 hours is plenty of time to fill your home with the scents you love. Any longer and your candle may get too hot and the wick may get too long. Put that flame out and let your candle solidify before trimming and lighting again.

5. Burn in a safe environment.

Place your candles on non-flammable, heat resistant surfaces and never leave a burning candle unattended. Also be aware that placing a hot candle on a cool surface like marble or glass may cause the vessel to crack.

It may seem like a lot for candle care, but trust us, these little tips are going to make you and your wax happy :)
